Today's lesson will study four aspects of the Holy Spirit baptizing the Church Age Believer

(1 Cor.12:12-13) "For even as the **body is one** and yet has many members, and all members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ. For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of **one Spirit.**"

- 1. Every Church Age Believer (CAB) receives Jesus' baptism with the Holy Spirit at the moment of Grace Salvation (1 Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9; Gal.3:2-3).**

At the moment of believing the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit does the following **eight works** of Grace Salvation. It is part of the package of 50 things every CAB receives in grace salvation that he can never lose in time or eternity. **SEE NOTES ON: [50 Things Free](#)**

Baptism	(Gal.3:27; 1 Cor.12:13)	Seals and Earnest	(Eph.1:13-14)
Indwelling	(1 Cor.6:19-20)	Spiritual gift	(1 Cor.12:11)
Regeneration	(John 3:1-8; Luke 1:35)	Spiritual life	(Rom.8:10-11; John 6:63)

- 2. At the moment of Grace Salvation, the Holy Spirit baptizes the CAB into Union with Jesus Christ seated at the right hand of God in the third heaven (Acts 2:33; Eph.2:18-22; Col.3:1-2).**

The Holy Spirit baptizes every CAB into headship of Jesus Christ who is the Savior of the body (Eph.5:23).

(Gal.3:27) "For all of you were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ."

- 3. "Being clothed with Christ" is the twenty status privileges of being in Union with Jesus Christ**

(Rom.15:16) "To be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, ministering as a priest the gospel of God, so that my offering of the Gentiles may become acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit."

(2 Cor.5:17). “Being clothed with Christ” is New Man identity”
