

### **THREE BAPTISMS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT**

This lesson will study three baptisms of the Holy Spirit mentioned in the New Testament (NT). These three baptisms of Holy Spirit involve all three members of the Godhead.

<b>This lesson will study these three baptisms of Holy Spirit by each member of the God head</b>

**NOTE:** Whenever all three members of the God Head are involved, it is a big deal!

**1. God, the Father baptized His Son with Holy Spirit at His water baptism by John Baptist (Matt.3:13-17; Mark 1:10-11; Luke 3:21-22; John 1:29-34; Isa.11:2; 42:1; 44:3; Acts 2:17).**

(John 1:32-34) "And John bore witness saying, 'I have **beheld the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven**, and He remained upon Him. And I did not recognize Him, but He who sent me to baptize in water said to me, 'He upon whom you see the Spirit descending and remaining upon Him, this is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.' And I have seen, and **have borne witness that this is the Son of God.**"

(Matt.3:16b) "... and behold, the heavens opened, and the he saw the **Spirit of God descending as a dove** and coming upon Him."

(Luke 12:50) This baptism began the earthly ministry of Jesus Christ. It ended with His baptism of death; (Mark 10:38).

**2. God, the Son baptized with The Holy Spirit at Pentecost to incorporate Old Covenant Believers and Gentiles into the New Covenant Church [Equally] (Matt.3:11; John 4:1-2; Acts 1:8).**

- **Jews** (Acts 1:4-5; 2:1-4, 32-33, 38-41)
- **Samaritan** (Acts 1:8; 8:1-4, 14-17)
- **Gentiles** (Acts 10:34, 42-46; 11:1-3, 15-18, 15:8-11)
- **John Baptist Ephesus disciples** (Acts 19:1-7; John 1:23, 30-34)

Jesus baptized with The Holy Spirit to incorporate these believers into the NC church equally (Gal.3:26-28).

**3. God, The Holy Spirit baptizes every Church Age Believer (CAB) at the moment of salvation (Rom.6:3-5).**

The Baptism of The Holy Spirit is [1 of 8 works of the Holy Spirit](#) at the moment of salvation. (Gal.3:2-3).

The Holy Spirit baptizes every CAB into union with Christ and into the church at salvation. (Gal.3:27; 1 Cor.12:13)
