

INDWELT BY THE SPIRIT FOREVER!

In our [last study](#) we learned that 50 days after Jesus' resurrection (The Jewish festival of First Fruits - Lev.23) and after 40 days of post-resurrection appearances, Jesus ascended back to Heaven and was seated at the right hand of God with All Authority (Acts 2:32-33).

We also learned that on the 50th day after His resurrection (The Jewish festival of Weeks - Lev.23), Jesus baptized 120 of His disciples into the His Church with the Advent of the Holy Spirit (Pentecost/ 30AD) in fulfillment of (Matt.3:11) (Acts 1:4-5, 15; 2:1).

We also learned that beginning with Pentecost (30AD), the Holy Spirit began writing and teaching the New Covenant Scriptures in the Church Age (27 Books of New Testament) (From 30AD to 100AD).

Jesus taught about the Advent of Holy Spirit in **John 14:16-16:15**.

This goes back to the beginning of His teaching on the Advent of Spirit to emphasize an importance doctrinal point - "that the Holy Spirit **indwells every CAB** (Church age believer) from the moment of salvation **FOREVER (John 14:16-17).**"

We will study four aspects of Quenching the Spirit by accepting the false premise that a believer can lose the INDWELLING of The SPIRIT by personal sin.

1. We can quench the Spirit by aborting the doctrinal principle of the permanent indwelling of The Holy Spirit.

We can Quench the Spirit by believing that we can lose the Holy Spirit's security, even after He accomplished His eight works at the moment of our salvation ([50 things FREE](#)).

We will mention 4 of the 8 Works of The Holy Spirit.

- **Indwelling forever** is one of these eight
 - (John 14:16-17).
- **Sealing-earnest** in time or eternity "**until the day of redemption**"
 - (Eph.1:13-14; 4:30-32; (2 Cor.1:21-22).
- **Spiritual birth** (regenerated) once born again always born again
 - (John 3:1-1-21; Titus 3:5-7; 1 Pet.1:23).
- **Spiritual life** is given at moment of salvation for time and eternity (Everlasting Life)
 - (1 John 5:11-13; Rom.8:9-11; Gal.5:25; 2 Cor.2:15-16) (life to life).

2. In our lesson text, Jesus gave two functioning titles to the ADVENT of the Holy Spirit:

- **Another Helper or Comforter** (allos parakletos) (John 14:16)
- **The Spirit of Truth** (to pneuma aletheia) (John 14:17)

In the context of John 14:16 to 16:15, Jesus refers to:

- The indwelling Spirit as the **Helper or Comforter four times** (John 14:16, 26; 15:26; 16:7)
- The indwelling Spirit as the **Spirit of Truth three times** (John 14:17; 15:26; 16:13).

Later John wrote and addressed the danger of the Holy Spirit's ministry as the "Spirit of Truth in:

(1 John 4:6) "We are from God, he who knows God listens to us; he who is not from God does not listen to us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error."

3. The Advent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost was not a mystery doctrine (Joel 2:28-32; Acts 2:14-21, 32-41).

One mystery doctrine in the church age, under the new covenant, **was the Indwelling of The Spirit in EVERY church age believer** (Enoikeo) (Rom.8:11; 2 Cor.6:16; Ex.25:8)

Shadow Christology (naos) (1 Cor.6:19-20; 2 Tm.2:14) **at the moment of salvation** (1 Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9) (John 15:26-27; Col.1:25-29; 2:2; Eph.3:3-6).

4. Jesus baptized with the Holy Spirit at Pentecost (30AD) so that the Holy Spirit could baptize every church age believer into Christ in heaven, and into the church body on earth from Pentecost to the Rapture of the Church (1 Thess.4:13-18).

- At the moment of salvation, the Holy Spirit baptizes the church age believer into Christ who is now seated at the right hand of God (Gal.3:26-29/ 3:16) (The seed is Christ).
- At the same moment, the Holy Spirit baptizes the church age believer into the Church body (1 Cor.12:13).
- At the same moment, the Holy Spirit gives every church age believer a spiritual gift which is their ministry to the church body (1 Cor.12:4-7).

(1Cor.12:11) "But **one and the same Spirit** works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills." Spiritual Gift (1 Cor.12:1, 28-30)

(1 Cor.12:13). "For by **one Spirit** we were **all baptized** into **one body**, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves of free, and we were all made to drink of **one Spirit.**"

Never let anyone mislead you to believe that you can either lose the indwelling of the Holy Spirit or your Grace Salvation secured by Christ in time and in eternity!

(John 14:16-17; Eph.2:8-9; Eph.1:13-14).
