

BAPTISM BY THE HOLY SPIRIT

I chose to divide the seventh foundation doctrine into two parts that are connected and misunderstood. The difference between Christ baptizing with Holy Spirit and **the Holy Spirit baptizing into Christ**.

In this lesson we will study four aspects of Baptism by Holy Spirit taken from (Gal.3:26-29).

- 1. The moment a person believes the gospel of grace salvation (1 Cor.15:3-4; Rom.1:16; Eph.2:8-9), the 13 judicial charges of Adam Original Sin are removed from his/ her life - in time and eternity (Rom.5:12-21).**

(Rom.5:12) “Therefore, just as through one-man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned.” (1 Cor15:22)

(Rom.5:21) “So that, as sin reigned in death, even so grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our lord.”

- 2. At the same time of believing the gospel of grace salvation, you receive the [eight works of the Holy Spirit](#) in the package of [50 Things Free](#).**

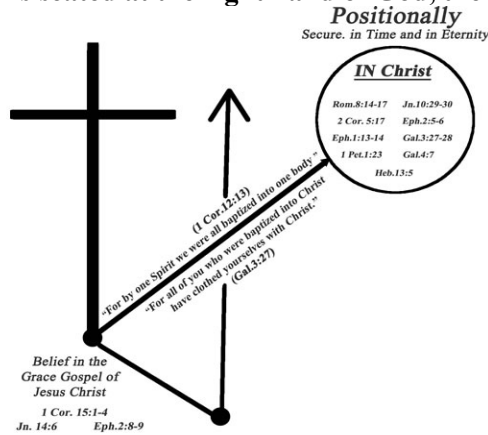
One of the eight works of the Holy Spirit is Baptism by Holy Spirit.

Paul listed four features to the Baptism by the Holy Spirit in (Gal.3:26-29).

- 3:26 - All who believe the gospel of grace salvation become **sons of God by faith**.
- 3:27 - All sons of God are **clothed with Christ** by the Baptism by the Holy Spirit.
- 3:28 - All sons of God, baptized by the Holy Spirit, are **one in Christ (equally)**.
- 3:29 - All sons of God **belong to Christ and** are **heirs of the promise to Abraham** (Rom.4:13; John 10:28-30).

3. The moment of grace salvation, the Baptism by the Holy Spirit (BHS) places the Church Age Believer IN Jesus Christ who is seated at the right hand of God, the Father in Heaven (Acts 2:33).



This is called **positional sanctification** (2 Cor.5:17 1 Cor.15:22; Rom.8:1; 15:16; 1 Cor.6:11).

(2 Thess.2:13-14) "But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because **God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth**. It was for this that He called you through the gospel, that you may gain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Positional sanctification applies to the Carnal believer as well as the Spiritual believer because it is based on grace salvation in the gospel of Jesus Christ (1 Cor.3:1-3; Gal.5:16-17; 1 John 1:9).

4. The moment of grace salvation, the Baptism by the Holy Spirit (BHS) places the Church Age Believer IN Jesus Christ into the body of Christ, the Church.

This is another doctrine of positional sanctification of the Baptism by the Holy Spirit into the body of Christ, the church. This is true for "all sons of God."

The moment of grace salvation, every Church Age Believer becomes a member of the body of Christ, the Church (1 Cor.12:12-27) [the word member (melos) is used 14 times in this passage.]

The doctrinal theme is "**many members, but ONE BODY.**" (1 Cor.12:12, 13, 14, 18, 19, 20, 25, 26, 27).

The Baptism by the Holy Spirit is responsible for the formation of the body of Christ, the Church (Eph.2:18-22; 4:4-6; 1 Cor.3:16; 6:19-20)

(Acts 1:8) is an outline for the formation of the church - ch.2; ch.8; chs.10-11; and ch.19.
